I mix Rembrandt brand acrylic paints with Liquitex ultra-matte gel so that the paint is very thick and the brushstrokes are marked. I paint the light spots first with a flat brush to simulate B

Following the same technique as in the previous step, I paint the brown spots.

In the same way I paint some black areas on the legs, eyes and near the muzzle.















Now I paint a light and a basic shadow on each of the spots. I continue mixing the paint with Liquitex ultra matte gel.

I prepare a base with oils, a light and a shadow with shades similar but this time on the brown spots. to those used with acrylics. I apply them on the white spots and blend the transitions.















To finish, I repeat the process with oils on the black surfaces.
